- That the performance will comply with Part 4 of The Children (Performances and Activities) (England) Regulations 2014 which applies "to all licensed performances and to all performances, which are exempted from the requirement to obtain a licence, under section 37(3)(a) of the 1963 Act .
- That suitable arrangements for the supervision of the children will be in place, with reference to DBS guidance on working with children in "regulated activity" and other appropriate guidance.
- That suitable arrangements for child safeguarding will be in place
